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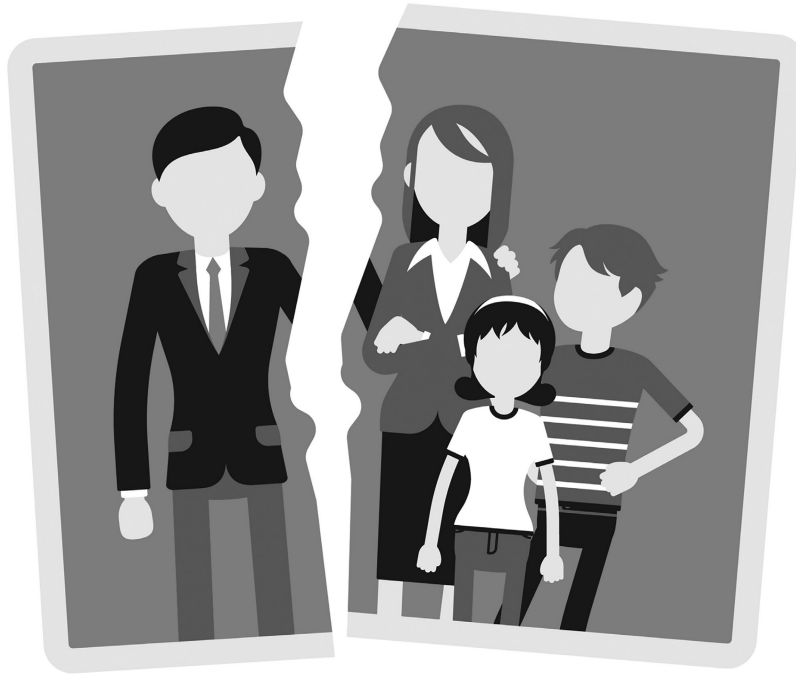

La lengua mapoyo, hablada por un pequeño grupo de indígenas de Venezuela, es la primera lengua que la UNESCO incluye en su lista de Patrimonio Cultural.

En el siglo XIX, el mapoyo era muy usado pero, a causa de la discriminación social que durante décadas hubo en Venezuela contra los pueblos indígenas, hoy en día la lengua solo es usada por un grupo de menos de 200 personas.

La UNESCO ha introducido programas para que el mapoyo se use en las escuelas locales.

- The teacher–examiner will ask the questions exactly as they are printed on the cards and may ask follow-up questions to develop the discussion of the sub-themes.
- You must ask the teacher–examiner one question arising from the material on each card. You can ask the question at any time during the discussion of the card.
- To develop the discussion of the sub-themes, you will be expected to respond to questions and discuss in **Spanish** broader issues within the sub-themes on the cards.
- You must **not** use a dictionary at any time during this test. This includes the preparation time.
