Homelessness amongst young people

What is homelessness? We can fall into the trap of thinking that it always means sleeping on the streets. But did you know that people can be homeless even when they have a roof over their heads?

19-year old Rebecca explains, "I live in different houses all the time. I sleep on friends' sofas and live out of a bag. I often don't know where I'll be staying from one week to the next."

Some of the biggest causes of youth homelessness are issues such as:

- family breakdown
- mental health problems
- high rents
- a lack of jobs for young people.

Llamau is one of the charities working with homeless young people in Wales. Chloe Morgan from Llamau says, "In the United Kingdom last year, 121 000 young people asked for help with homelessness. But there are many more who don't know where to turn."

If you're aware of someone who is homeless, you should contact the local council for help. You can also contact a service called StreetLink that will connect homeless people with support teams or a night shelter.

Despite the challenges, it's important to remember that there can be light at the end of the tunnel. One young person who has recently turned his life around is Kyle Wilson. Kyle says, "During the Covid pandemic, I lost my job as a bricklayer and then lost my flat. It was so difficult to get help during the lockdown and I had to sleep on park benches."

However, with support, Kyle now has a new job. "I'm so glad everything has worked out", he says. "I know from experience that homelessness is devastating. It can be dangerous and also very lonely."
