- (ii) Using sociological evidence and examples, explain why people of some social classes are more likely to experience ill health than others. [20]

- (b) Discuss the accuracy of official statistics on health and illness. [40]

Or,

- (c) Discuss the usefulness of feminists' contributions to health and disability. [40]

Option 3 World Sociology**Compulsory question**

3. (a) (i) Explain the meaning of the term Transnational Corporation (TNC). [10]
- (ii) Using sociological evidence and examples, explain the relationship between education and inequality in the developing world. [20]

Either,

- (b) Discuss sociological explanations for the lack of development in Less Economically Developed Countries (LEDCs). [40]

Or,

- (c) Assess feminist views of inequality in the developing world. [40]
