陳萍說：“我很喜歡我的學校，但是我之後沒有上大學，因為我不想再花四年的時間在學校裡，讓父母為我花錢，我想快點開始工作。”

現在，陳萍的公司遍佈世界各地，她除了去各個國家出差，她還會花一些時間去學校和學生們分享她的創業經歷。

- 25 陳萍最後說：“我從我的工作中學到了兩個非常重要的道理。第一，你一定要努力工作才能成功。第二，重要的不是你知道什麼，而是你怎麼使用這些知識。”同時，她也給年輕人提出了一些建議：年輕人要記住，每個人的生活中都有很多挑戰，關鍵是你怎麼面對這些挑戰，你應該自己做出自己的選擇，相信你自己。
