**SCENARIO 2: Learning**

Last year you went to a German-speaking country to visit a school/college. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **German**, for the language section of your school/college website.

**You must include** the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- how you travelled **and** what you did during the journey
- what you thought of the school/college
- how you got on with the people you met
- what you did in the evenings
- what food and drink you tried
- whether you would repeat this experience.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
